

The township's park and recreation study group held its second meeting Tuesday Nov. 13. Attending were Tom Osborne, supervisor; John Voyta, planning commission member, and Yancy Unger.

The township has included \$5,000 in its proposed 2013 budget for a study on building facilities on township property. A letter is being prepared to send to at least eight companies that have been identified as doing parks and rec planning, seeking bids on such a study. Mr. Unger agreed to seek input from the region's parks person at the state Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, in addition to contacting the Pa. Recreation and Parks Society to solicit its help in finding funding for our proposed project.

In addition, Mr. Osborne will attend a grant workshop in February, sponsored by DCNR and the recreation and parks society.

The township is hoping to construct a ball field, a picnic pavilion and a walking trail at the site.
